## ~Boise River Float Trips~

#### A Message from University Housing:

When international students leave at the end of their program or at the end of a semester, we consistently have difficulty returning housing security deposits to them. To increase the number of students who receive their security deposit refund, we are going to attempt to refund these security deposits directly to the card the student used to make the initial payment. There are a few stipulations to this:

1. The student must email BsuHousing@boisestate.edu requesting the refund be sent straight to the card they used to make the original payment and provide us with their student ID number and name.

2. Only students who have paid their security deposit via our online application (Residence Hall) are eligible to have their refunds processed this way. Apartment tenants pay their deposit through BroncoWeb and the deposit will refunded via the normal method used by Payment and Disbursement.

3. In all cases security deposits are used to first cover damages to a student's assignment, secondly to cover any outstanding charges with University Housing and to thirdly cover any outstanding charges with the University in general. Any remaining funds are refunded to the student.
