### **Immigration Check-in**

Check-in for all international students will be held Monday, Jan 31<sup>st</sup> thru' Friday, Feb 4<sup>th</sup>. This check-in is **required** by

U.S. Immigration to maintain your legal status as an F-1 or J-1 visa holder.

Check-in takes approximately 15 minutes to complete. You must come to the Student Diversity Center (SDC) in the Student Union Building (SUB)

between 9:30am and 4:00pm any day that week (January 31 – February 4) to fulfill this requirement.

Any student who does not attend the check-in session will be fined a \$50 fee.

NOTE: If you are a new international student and attended the orientation January 12 & 13, you are checked-in with immigration. There is no need for you to participate in this check-in session this semester. You will need to attend check in next semester.
