




### Rethinking: Change



- Multiple users at a time for many library eBooks—facilitates course readings, research, and reserves.



Alexander Street Press and Films on Demand provide an extensive collection of streaming videos on a variety of topics and disciplines. Many of these videos are available to watch on your desktop or your mobile device; can be embedded in coursework pages or Blackboard; or sections of video trimmed to specific segments.

### American History in Video

American History in Video includes approximately 1,000 hours of newsreels from the late 1890s to the 1980s. Beginning with the Spanish American War, the early films provide documentary footage of actual people, places, and events together with interviews and other broadcast content from the period.

### Counseling and Therapy in Video
