Classified State Employee Survey

This message is being shared to let Managers and Classified Employees know that the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee for the State of Idaho has directed the Office of Performance Evaluation (OPE) to study employee compensation and turnover in state government. OPE is surveying **classified employees by e-mail** to identify factors that influence an employee's decision to either remain

in a job or leave for a position elsewhere.

The survey should take about 10 minutes to complete and must be completed by **Tuesday, August 7**. Participation is **not** mandatory, although participation will help inform legislators during the 2013 Legislative Session.

All survey responses will be kept confidential. No individual responses will be shared with agencies

or other parties, and no information will be reported in such a way that could identify a person and his or her responses.
