Immigration Check-in

Check-in for all international students will be held Tuesday, Sep 6th thru' Friday, Sep 9th. This check-in is **required** by U.S. Immigration to maintain your legal status as an F-1 or J-1 visa holder. Check-in takes approximately 15 minutes to complete. You must come to the Student Diversity Center (SDC) in the Student Union Building (SUB) between 9:30am and 4:00pm any day that week (September 6 thru' September 9) to fulfill this requirement.

Any student who does not attend the check-in session will be fined a \$50 fee.

NOTE: If you are a new international student and attended the orientation August 17 & 18, you are checked-in with immigration. There is no need for you to participate in the check-in session this semester. You will need to attend check in next semester.

Curricular Practical Training (CPT), also called an Internship, allows a student to work off-campus for a specified amount of time in a position related to his/her field of study. If you plan to do an internship as part of your academic program, you need to attend a CPT Workshop.

September 12, 12:00 to 1:00pm September 15, 4:00 to 5:00pm

<u>Please email Christy or Merrilou to sign up for a workshop. Be sure to indicate which</u> <u>session you wish to attend.</u> Workshops will be held in the Student Diversity Center.

Optional Practical Training (OPT) is a one-year work permit that allows international students to work in their field of study after graduation. <u>If you are graduating this</u> semester and are interested in applying for OPT, you *must* attend an OPT Workshop.

September 15, 9:00 to 11:00am September 19, 3:00 to 5:00pm September 22, 4:00 to 5:30pm

When attending the workshop, you must bring your I-20, visa, passport and I-94 card, plus 2 passport-size photos (head positioned directly facing the camera) and a Money Order for \$380.00 payable to CIS. <u>Please email Christy or Merrilou to sign up for a</u> workshop. Be sure to indicate which session you wish to attend. Workshops will be held in the Student Diversity Center.
