#### What is GLACIER?

GLACIER is an online tax system used to determine the proper tax withholding on payments to international students. International students who receive payments from Boise State (scholarships, wages, awards, prizes or travel payments) will be asked to complete a GLACIER tax record. If you receive a request to complete a GLACIER record it is important to do this as soon as possible. The GLACIER system will send you information from the email address support@online-tax.net. If you receive an email from this address it is important to follow up as soon as possible. Failure to complete GLACIER or follow up on requests sent from support@online-tax.net may result in too much tax being withheld from payments to you.
