Immigration Info

Are you planning to travel outside the U.S. during Winter Break?

- ① **Remember, you must have your I-20 signed before you leave.** Bring your I-20 to the ISS office at least 72 hours before you travel to give us time to complete the process. It is important that you are registered for Spring classes before bringing your I-20 to ISS.
- ② **Check the status of your visa.** If it has expired, or will expire while you are outside of the US, you must plan to have it renewed before you return. Documents you will need for this process are an unofficial transcript, a copy of your class registration for the Spring semester and a Visa Support letter from ISS.
- ③ **Check the status of your passport.** If your passport will expire while you are away, be sure to follow the regulations of your home country to renew your passport before you return. If you are remaining in the US, you still must have a valid passport. You may contact the consulate for your country in the US to find out the renewal process.

Reminder Regarding Health Insurance:

You Will Be Automatically Enrolled in SHIP (Student Health Insurance Program) and Will Be Charged the Premium for the Spring, 2012 Semester . . . **UNLESS** you go online and file the required waiver. This must be done each semester. *In fact, you can file the waiver for Spring semester right now!* Just go to <http://healthservices.boisestate.edu/insurance/> and complete the waiver application. Please remember to read and respond to any email messages you receive back from the SHIP office. They may be asking you for additional information. The sooner you respond and provide that information, the sooner your waiver can be approved!
