Immigration Check-in LAST DAY February 8th

Last day for Check-in for *all* continuing international students will be held <u>Friday, Feb. 8th</u> This check-in is **required** by U.S. Immigration to maintain your legal status as an F-1 or J-1 visa holder. Check-in takes approximately 15 minutes to complete. You must come to the

Student Diversity Center (SDC) in the Student Union Building (SUB) between 9:30am and 4:00pm to fulfill this requirement.

Any student who does not attend the check-in session will be fined \$50.00.

NOTE: If you are a new international student and attended the orientation January 16th and 17th, you are checked-in with immigration. You do not need to participate in the check-in session this semester. You will need to attend check-in next semester.


Games with International and American Students
