

DEBRA K. RIEDEL 2013 SILVER MEDALLION RECIPIENT



DEBRA K. RIEDEL exemplifies what it means to be a Bronco.

She holds two degrees from Boise State University – a bachelor's degree in music education (1977) and a master's degree in music/performance (1999). She is a dedicated alumna, investing deeply in the university, its growth and its students. Her successful career in the finance industry, where she is the first vice president and wealth management portfolio manager at Morgan Stanley, is matched only by her commitment and dedicated service to the community.

As a student of music Deb was "one of the finest graduates to have ever graced our program," according to Del Parkinson, a professor of music who nominated Deb for the Silver Medallion. Primarily a pianist, Deb also sang in all the university vocal ensembles as a student and served as a member of the Keith Stein Blue Thunder Marching Band.

In her professional life, Deb joined EF Hutton in 1983 and persevered through the many corporate mergers that eventually resulted in creation of today's Morgan Stanley, where she specializes in private wealth

management and consulting. She is an honoree of the Barron's Winner Circle, which recognizes the "best of the best" in the nation's financial industry for their ethical standards, professionalism and success. She also is the former board chairman of the Treasure Valley United Way and a past recipient of the Tribute to Women in Industry Award, an honor bestowed by the Women and Children's Alliance. In 2009, she was named Idaho Business Review Women of the Year.

As a Boise State alumna, Deb's ongoing dedication and hard work on behalf of Boise State, was recognized in 2011 with the university's Distinguished Alumni award. She has served on the board of the Boise State University Foundation since 2000, including a term as its president 2004-2006. Her philanthropic support of the university includes student scholarships, such as her personal establishment of an endowed scholarship for music students, and the Department of Music's successful campaign to make Boise State the first All-Steinway School in Idaho. Also, as a lifetime member of the Boise State Alumni Association, she is a stalwart supporter of its effort to build a new Boise State Alumni and Friends Center.

Deb is an Idaho native and enjoys the great Idaho lifestyle. She lives in Boise with her husband Kelly Turk, who also is an alumnus of Boise State's music program (1984).

ALAN AND WENDY PESKY are ardent supporters of improved education who want to recognize extraordinary teachers who ignite a fire in their students. Because of their passion, they have created the Pesky Award for Inspirational Teaching to honor four distinguished Idaho K-12 teachers and their schools.

Gina Bush

Maple Grove Elementary (Boise, Idaho – Boise Independent School District), 6th grade teacher • General Education

Gina Bush was perfect in every way. She was strict, yet soft and nurturing. She had high expectations but was always realistic and had unbelievable patience. Everything we learned in her class felt important and useful. I strived to do my

very best on all things we did in her class because she had given true value to everything we were taught. When I got to Boise State and selected my major it was hands down elementary education. I was determined to be the teacher that made the difference. I wanted to be the teacher that was likeable, fun, and engaging, yet productive with high expectations for her students. I was so excited to be a teacher and worked so hard for three years to get to my student teaching year. After months of waiting and wondering where I was going to be placed for my student teaching, I finally got the email. I scrolled down, found my mentor teacher's name and cried. My mentor teacher was Mrs. Gina Bush from Maple Grove Elementary, sixth grade. The teacher who had changed my outlook on school and was one of the biggest reasons for me wanting to be a teacher myself, was now going to be my mentor as I learn to teach.

Steve Hansen

Payette Lakes Middle School (McCall, Idaho - McCall-Donnelly School District), 7th grade teacher • Math, Special Education Since sixth grade Steve Hansen always made sure I had everything I needed for school. Mr. Hansen moved to the high school when I was in ninth grade. Throughout high school he would help me with my math and writing and anything else I needed help with. During my high school years I was also able to see him in the resource room and see how great he was with kids with disabilities. I would hear them say, "I can't do this." Mr. Hansen would say, "You can't say that in my classroom. You have to at least try and then we can talk about ways that you can accomplish what you are trying to do." I have always remembered these words and to this day I use that with my students and my kids. I learned from Mr. Hansen that when you are a teacher your job doesn't end when the bell rings. It doesn't end when the year is over either. Once you have met a child that child is a part of your life forever. He taught me that when you are a teacher you are more than just a teacher.

Jean Mortin

Grace Jordan Elementary (Boise, Idaho – Boise Independent School District), Kindergarten and 1st grade teacher • General Education

Jean Mortin is one of the most dedicated, passionate, and inspirational teachers I have ever met. "I am not one of those teachers that believes I am underpaid." This is one of the first things that Mrs. Mortin said to me. I personally have never heard a teacher say that and it took me by surprise! I quickly learned that this mindset is genuine to Jean Mortin. Throughout my life I have had many inspirational teachers that have developed my love for education. Jean Mortin did not come into my life until recently, but she has managed to completely change much of my inspiration for educating. I have learned to look at children through a lens of unconditional love. Mrs. Mortin genuinely loves every child that walks through her door. She cares about them now and about their futures. Jean Mortin's favorite type of child to work with is the child that struggles the most. She is incredible at what she does and loves every minute of it. "Happy Friday!" is not a phrase Mrs. Mortin enjoys. She usually responds with something along the lines of, "What could you be doing this weekend that is better than teaching first graders?"

For Art Sprague, teaching is not just a job; it is a passion he has for making a difference in the lives of others. That
may seem cliché, but he shows his passion in many ways. He runs a K-Kids program after school helping his students
become involved in making a difference in their community. He also coaches basketball in Meridian and encourages
kids to stay active and healthy. His involvement in his school community is strong, as well. He runs the school food
drives, takes care of morning announcements, sets up field day at the end of the school year, and fills in whenever he is
needed. All of those things make him a wonderful teacher, but as wonderful as all of those accomplishments are, they
are not the things that have made me stay the course on my road to becoming a teacher. It is the moments where he
joins an IEP meeting to advocate for a student, or when he sits on the floor next to a student during a performance
just to make them comfortable about performing in front of an audience full of parents and friends, or when he
volunteers to be the PTO president because no one else will do it and he wants to ensure that his students have the
programs they need to help them be successful in school. Those are the moments that my heart feels full and I realize
that teachers and students make a difference in each other's lives.

Prepared, conscientious, positive and intelligent is how Leslie Durham, Associate Dean of Arts and Humanities, describes TIARA ROSE THOMPSON. A native Idahoan, Thompson is graduating with a double major in Theatre Arts and English.

Thompson believes her perseverance and appreciation for life have led to her success in college — she has earned honors on the Dean's List almost every semester. 
Thompson studied abroad in France for the spring 2012 semester and met many amazing people who she says were intrigued by her love for her school and home state of Idaho.



CEREMONIAL TRADITIONS

The Commencement exercise is a fitting conclusion to a successful academic career and earning of a university degree. The ceremony is based on 800 years of academic tradition handed down from European universities of the Middle Ages. Commencement ceremonies, with their academic gowns, mortarboards, tassels, hoods and maces, are colorful, festive and dignified. It is a ceremony to recognize the successes of the University and the students who merit degrees.

ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The academic procession is a featured part of the commencement program - a symbolic declaration that all members of the academic community are bound by a common purpose and shared commitment to the ideals of higher education, including the search for meaning, truth and understanding.

The presidential party - the president, the provost, the vice presidents, and deans - is led by a mace bearer, who is a faculty member and the president of the faculty senate.

THE MACE

The mace, generally made of wood and clad in metal, was used as a weapon during the Middle Ages. The mace has evolved into a symbol of authority and is carried at commencement and at ceremonies where honors or degrees are to be awarded.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps, gowns, and hoods in the processional are symbolic of the Middle Ages. Because universities developed from church schools, both faculty and students were regarded as part of the clergy and wore clerical clothing based on monastic dress.

The traditional hat developed from the skull cap worn in cold weather. In Europe, a bonnet with tassel is still worn, but in America it has been replaced by the mortarboard cap or tam with tassel. The bachelor's gown, with its long, pointed sleeves, is worn closed. The master's gown has an oblong sleeve open at the wrist; the rear section is square cut. The doctor's gown often was furred, a decoration that survives today as the velvet on the front and sleeves.

The tassel colors seen in the processional correspond to the field of study.

THE MASTER'S HOOD

The academic hood was originally worn over the head in bad weather. Now, it is added to the apparel of those who earn master's and doctoral degrees.

The colors on the hoods represent two things: the wearer's Alma Mater and the department of learning. The silk lining is in the colors of the college or university granting the degree. The velvet trim is the color that represents the departments of learning in which the degree was obtained.

The academic hood, presented by Boise State University's Graduate College, displays a blue and orange chevron, denoting the University's colors. The color of the velvet border represents the field of study in which the degree is awarded.
