THE SELECTION, "PSALM OF THANKSGIVING" WAS WRITTEN IN THE FALL OF 1967 ON A COMMISSION BY MRS. LUCY B. LEMANN, OF NEW YORK, WITH THE GENERAL SUBJECT OF THANKSGIVING, NOT SPECIFICALLY OUR NATIONAL HOLIDAY, BUT STRESSING THE IMPORTANCE AND THE BEAUTY OF GIVING THANKS, OF GRATITUDE. THIS WORK USES THE WELL-KNOWN CHORALE PRELUDE, "NUN DANKET," (NOW THANK WE ALL OUR GOD) WITH THE TEXT TAKEN FROM PSALM 107, AND A REFRAIN SUNG BY THE CHILDREN'S CHOIR, "O THAT MEN WOULD PRAISE THE LORD FOR HIS GOODNESS, AND FOR HIS WONDERFUL WORKS TO THE CHILDREN OF MEN."
