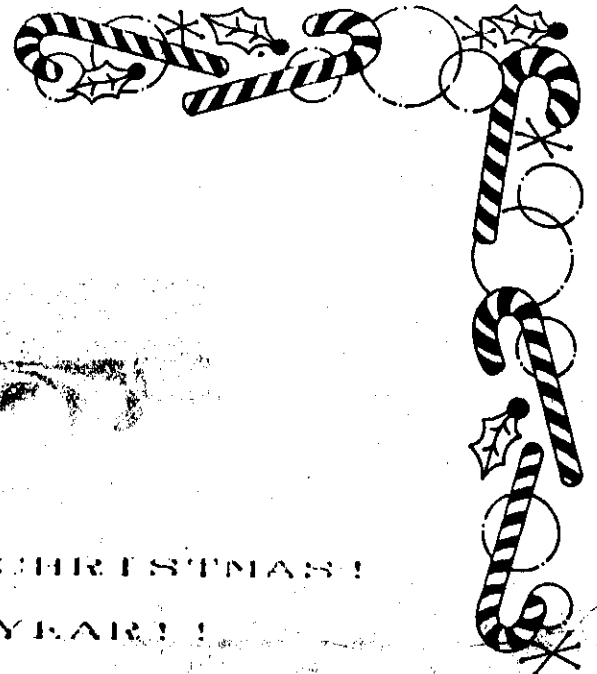
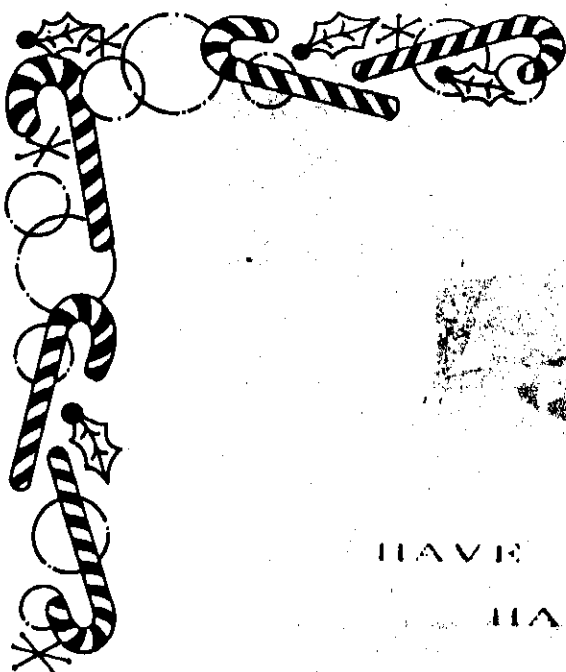
Roxanne Dehlin and Sherry McNeal were granted B.S.U.A.O.P. scholarships for Spring Semester.
