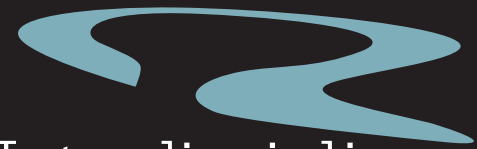

He has co-hosted the PBS Nature series *American Spring Live*, and has appeared as a guest on programs ranging from NPR's *Fresh Air* to *On Point*, *Science Friday*, *The World*, *The Splendid Table*, and *Book Lust* with Nancy Pearl. Hanson is the author of *Buzz*, *The Triumph of Seeds*, *Feathers*, and *The Impenetrable Forest*. His popular articles and essays have appeared in publications ranging from *Audubon* and *Orion* to *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Times of London*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *The American Scholar*, *The Guardian*, and *The Huffington Post*.
