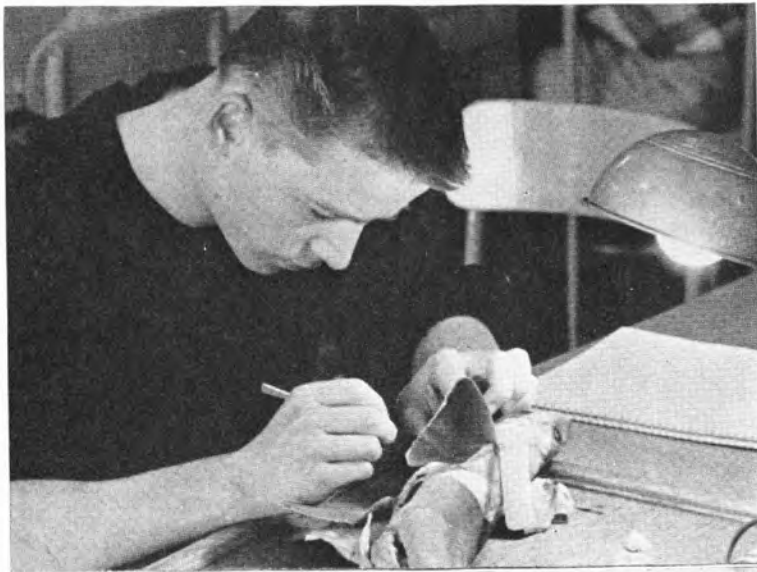

Sherrill Beaman is studying the anatomy of a shark in his zoology lab. After 18 weeks of intensive study on his shark he will know it "inside out."



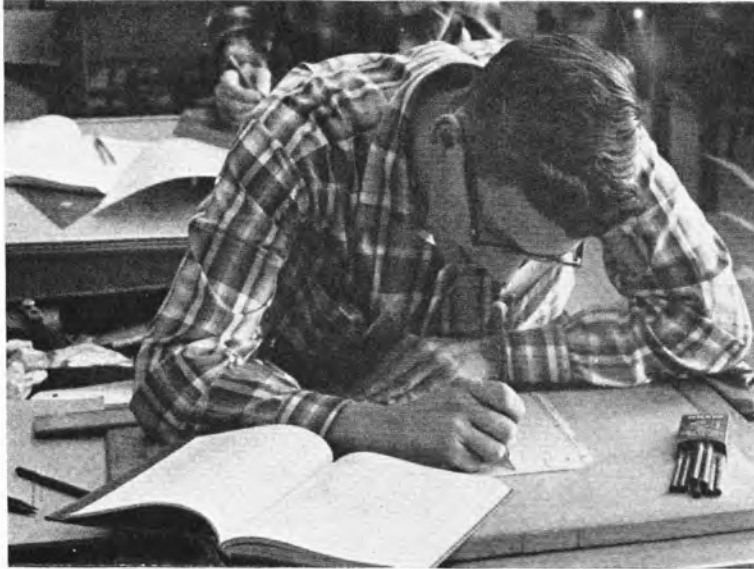
The business majors gain proficiency in typing, shorthand, accounting, and business math and law.

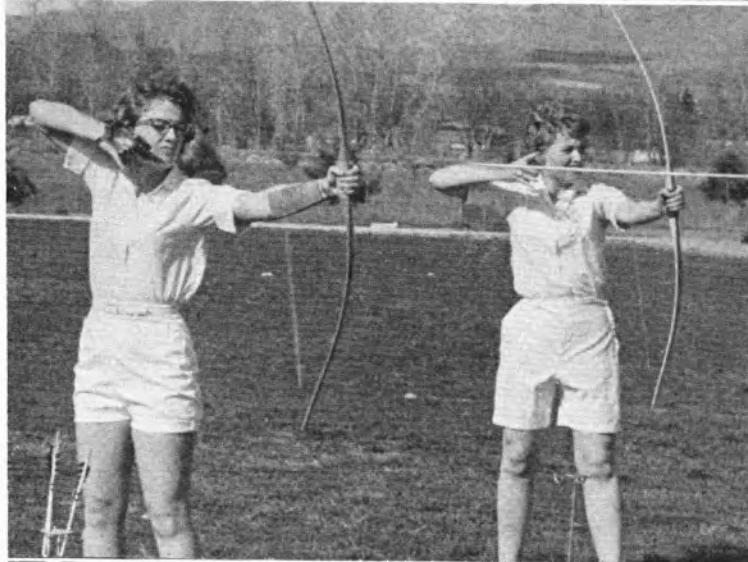
Engineering majors spend much of their time over a drafting board working out various problems. They also take courses in surveying, mathematics and physical science.



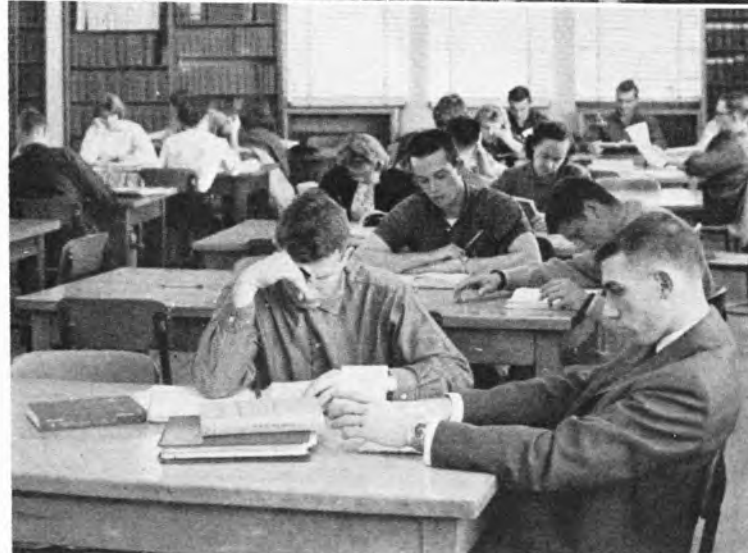
Ellen Garlinghouse and Billie Ferguson are learning to operate notary calculators. These business majors learn to operate various machines used in business offices.



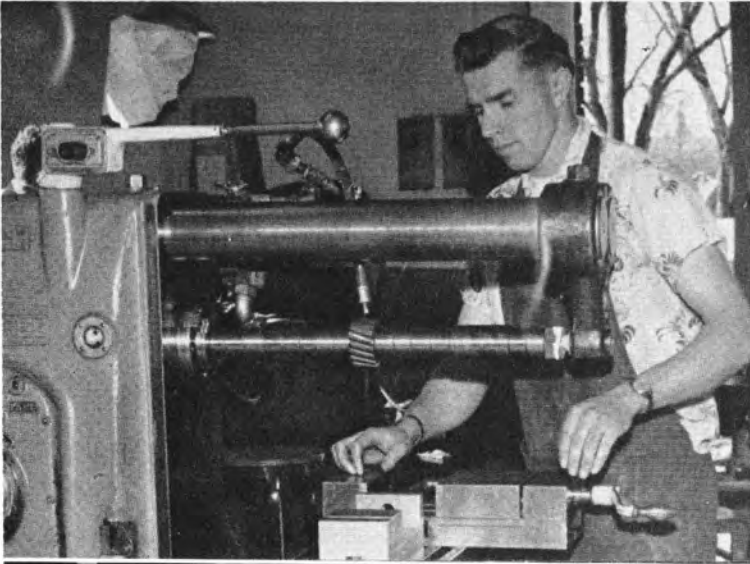
These hunters are exploring the exciting world of the microbe. Life Science majors have access to more than 5000 slides to study in addition to live specimens.
