Immigration Check-in Starts February 3rd

Check-in for **all** continuing international students is being held

Monday, Feb. 3rd thru' Friday, Feb. 7th.

This check-in is **required** by U.S. Immigration to maintain your legal status as an F-1 or J-1 visa holder.

This semester we will be doing check-in online. You will **NOT** be required to come to International Student Services to participate in this process. Be sure to watch your Boise State email for detailed instructions for completing the online check-in.

Any student who does not respond to the check-in requirement by 5:00 pm on Feb. 7th, will be fined \$50.00.

Any student who does not check-in before Feb. 18th will be fined an **additional \$50.00** (a total of \$100.00) for failure to comply with immigration requirements.

ISS must register all students in SEVIS by February 19th in order to maintain student status.

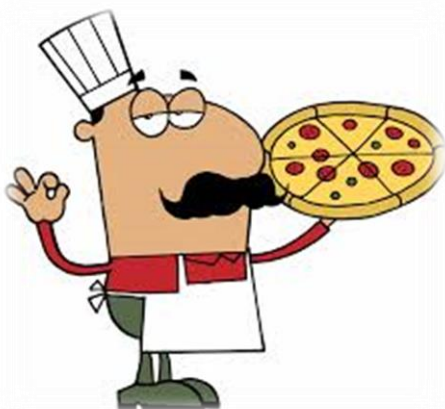
NOTE FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: *If you are a new international student and attended the orientation January 15th and 16th, you are checked-in with immigration.*

You do not need to participate in the check-in session this semester.

You will need to follow the directions for check-in for the Fall semester.

FREE assistance with tax return forms!

The Glacier Tax Prep software is a web based tax preparation software package specifically for nonresident alien taxpayers that is available to international students who need to complete a US tax return. The software will be available through your Glacier record by mid-February. You will receive an email when access becomes available. This service is free to the international taxpayers. If you do not have a GLACIER record but would like to use the software then you may request access by contacting Suzy White at swhite@boisestate.edu.

The official US tax returns are due on April 15th; don't put it off for the last minute!
